Uniform Information:

"Class A" is the complete BSA Field Uniform. This includes Tan shirt, khaki green pants, neckerchief (provided by Troop at crossover), green epaulets and proper footwear. Class A uniforms are to be worn at all Troop Meetings, unless otherwise designated, and to and from all campouts...without exception. Scouts are also expected to wear Class A uniforms to Scoutmaster Conferences and Boards of Review.

Certain events dictate a more formal look, in which tennis shoes and hiking boots will not be permitted. When indicated, these events will require dress shoes. NO JEANS are to be worn in place of the uniform pant. Our Troop has a uniform bank if a scout is in need of "used" uniform parts or dress shoes to help aid in the expense of the uniform. Please contact the Scoutmaster or Committee Chairman if you would like to access our uniform bank.



Paperwork & Troop Fees:

We will need a completed "New Scout Application" to transfer your scout to the Troop. Additionally the Troop has a \$25 activity fee upon crossing over. Your scout will receive a Class B Tshirt, Neckerchief and Green Epaulets from the Troop. Our annual Troop Activity Fee \$35 and will be collected at rechartering time in November. At your first Troop Meeting, we will need a completed Annual Health and Medical

Record. We would also like to have the contact information for both parents, including cell numbers and email addresses.



Parent Involvement and Participation:

While we do not expect everyone to become a uniformed adult leader, we would like to have parents involved in some way to help the program operate as it should. There are positions on the Committee (See John Uhran) or in Program Area as Assistant Scoutmasters (See Rob Boehm) to become a registered leader with the Troop, however we also are in need of adults who can help with
